After time, and multiple uses, the product can be returned to our UK based recycling centre to be assessed by our experts who will decide the best option for the product. We endeavour to repair as many products as possible before sending on to our **Second Life™** programme



REPAIRED

If the product is deemed repairable, for example, slight wear or rips to the material, we will repair and return to the customer. Through the repair service we can extend a product's initial lifecycle and more than double its number of uses. Our main focus for the future is sustainability, and how we can create a process that eliminates waste by developing our products so that they last longer and have multiple uses. We haven't stopped there, we also wanted to create a process that increases a product's lifecycle even further by being repaired and then given a 'second life' through regeneration.

SECOND LIFE™



As with all products, there comes a natural end to their life cycle and despite our efforts, will become irreparable. When this time comes, the product will be given a new lease of life and enter into our **Second Life™** programme.

There are several routes that the product can take after it has gone through the **Second Life™** programme.

- · Insulation products for sound and agriculture
- Waste protection products
- Second Life[™] products such as bags and laptop cases
- Reusing the materials for producs within your supply chain such as pallet pr machinery covers.

We will supply a CO2 certificate for any customer that uses our recycling programme detailing the carbon emission savings made through **Second Life™**

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OUR RECYCLING CENTRE

At our UK based recycling centre we estimate that we'll be able to process 2,500 tonnes of fabric per annum, saving upto 16,400 tonnes of CO2 every year.





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
